Thanksgiving Offering: Thank you for your generous giving to Samaritan's Purse for tornado relief, which totaled \$46,496. While the initial relief effort was so impactful on our community, we are working with other churches to follow-up with those who made decisions for Christ through the work of Samaritan's Purse. We are also very grateful for your generosity in giving \$8,761 to support our internship program.

Celebrate Missions Offering: As part of Celebrate Missions we will be supporting several ministry projects:

- Camp scholarships with Word of Life Quebec (Goal: \$1,950)
- Bible distribution with Hockey Ministries International (Goal: \$1,205)
- Heritage College global ministries scholarships (Goal: \$10,000)
- Heritage student/faculty local outreach opportunities (Goal: \$4,000)
- Heritage College ethnic Pastor training (Goal: \$6,000)
- Disaster relief outreach (Goal: \$10,000)
