For the past two thousand years, Paul's letter to the Romans has been changing lives because it proclaims the big truths of the gospel—righteousness, salvation, justification, reconciliation, propitiation to name just a few. These truths will astonish us, as we learn how God desires to save us through the Lord Jesus Christ. They will enable us to experience the freedom God wants for us, his adopted and beloved children, as we live in the power of his Holy Spirit. And these truths will embolden us to proclaim them with confidence and joy to those who have yet to believe.

For the next few months, we'll explore the big truths of the gospel by breaking them into 4 parts:

- Part 1 The Righteousness of God
- Part 2 The Grace of God
- Part 3 The Will of God
- Part 4 The Community of God

Within each of these 4 parts, we will dig deeper into key words or phrases as we walk through Paul's letter to the Romans. Some words or phrases are fleshed out even further in the Glossary and Suggested Resources on page 86 and 88 to this guide.

Whether this is the first time you've ever read Paul's letter to the Romans, or you've read it many times, we pray that you will see the big truths of the gospel in new ways over the course of our study. Even more, we pray that as you learn, experience and proclaim the big truths of the gospel, God will use them to change your life, making you more like His son, the Lord Jesus Christ.

Studying the Big Truths of the Gospel

Over the course of our study, we encourage you to read through Paul's letter to the Romans at least once. We have provided a separate copy of Romans to help you do this. As you read, underline things that stand out and make notes in the margins. Look for repetition and how certain passages highlight the big truths of the gospel. Note your observations and your questions. Some of you might even find it helpful to even write out the letter over the course of our study so that the words sink even deeper into your hearts and minds.

Each week, we invite you to study a specific passage of Romans so that you can learn, experience and proclaim the big truths of the gospel. We encourage you to begin your reading with prayer. Then, answer at least one question from three categories, all of which are reproduced on a stand-alone card: (1) learn, (2) experience, and (3) proclaim. End your time with more prayer, praising God for the gospel and asking him to allow the weekly passage to transform you as he has planned.

Pray

- Ask God to focus your mind and block out any distractions so that you can fully commit your time to Him.
- Ask God to open your eyes, heart and mind to the truths in his word.

<u>Learn</u>

- Does Paul address a particular issue or problem in this passage?
- 2. Are there any words that Paul repeats or emphasizes? If so, what are they?
- 3. How does this passage connect to the one before or after it in Romans?
- 4. Does Paul refer to another passage of the Bible? What is it and what does he say about it?

Experience

- Does the passage cause you to feel any emotion(s) and why?
- 2. Does something in this passage convict you in a particular way? Why or how?
- 3. Does Paul refer to one or more Persons of the Trinity God the Father, God the Son (Jesus Christ), God the Holy Spirit? If so, how and why?
- 4. What big truth does the passage explain and have you ever experienced it in your journey of faith?

Proclaim

- 1. Summarize the passage in your own words.
- 2. Choose 1-2 verses from the passage that resonated with you. Write them out and/or commit them to memory.
- 3. Can you see parallels between the passage and trends in our culture today? If so, how and what are they?
- 4. How can you use this passage to share the gospel with others in your life?

Praise

- How does this passage lead you to praise and worship God?
- For what can you thank him today?

Glossary of Selected Big Truths of the Gospel

Faith – Wholehearted trust in something you cannot explicitly prove.

Gentile - Someone who is not ethically Jewish.

Gospel – A word that literally means "good news." In the Bible, it refers to the good news concerning Jesus Christ and the way of salvation.

Grace – Unmerited favour and used to describe how God treats his people in the Bible.

Hebrew – A Jew and a member of the nation of Israel.

Holy - Totally pure and set apart.

Justify – To declare something righteous. Justification is an act of God whereby He pronounces a sinner to be righteous because of that sinner's faith in Christ.

Law – God's standards given throughout the Bible, such as those given to Moses and the people of Israel (e.g., the Ten Commandments).

Propitiation – A two-part act that involves appeasing the wrath of God and being reconciled to Him through the death of Jesus Christ.

Reconcile – To restore a friendship by settling or resolving differences with another person.

Redeem – To free, release, or buy back something or someone for a price.

Remnant – A small, remaining quantity of something. In the Bible, it refers to a small number of Jews who returned from the exile from the land of Babylon.

Repent – A military word that literally means "about turn."

Righteousness – Behavior that is morally justifiable or right, and characterized by accepted standards of morality, justice, virtue, or uprightness.

Salvation – The deliverance from danger or suffering. It carries the idea of victory, health, protection, or preservation. It can be used in a physical sense, but in the Bible it refers to deliverance from sin.

Sanctity – Purity and Christlikeness. Sanctification is the process of growing in sanctity.

Spiritual Gifts – Abilities given to believers by God so that they can serve in the church such as prophesying, serving, teaching, encouraging, giving, leadership, mercy, faith, healing, and miraculous powers.

Trinity – The Bible teaches that is only one God, but that God exists in three persons: Father, Son (Jesus Christ) and Holy Spirit.

Wrath – Strong and vengeful anger in response to a real or perceived injustice.
